





### WHAT ARE THE CURRENT RESTRICTIONS IN THE UK?

Regular testing has become the norm and the UK has been following a set programme where restrictions have been gradually eased. As of 21st June 2021, the government has announced there should be few restrictions in place.







In such circumstances, St Giles endeavours to offer the best alternative arrangements, dates or venues available, including online tuition. If an alternative cannot be provided, a refund of fees paid for tuition and/or accommodation will be offered but St Giles does not accept liability for further compensation which exceeds the total fees paid.

St Giles (and associated third party suppliers) reserve the right to refuse to accept, to admit onto the premises or cancel a student's course or accommodation due to overriding health and safety concerns, or in cases where we or the accommodation provider cannot make reasonable provisions to facilitate their leaning needs or for their personal care.
